Environmental Protection Statement & Policy (EPSP)

<u>Goal</u>: To provide a framework for establishing culture in our business, with a mindedness toward protecting the environment of our jurisdiction and outside our jurisdiction.

<u>**Responsibilities:**</u> Management will be responsible for follow up and due diligence to satisfy internal policies and legal requirements. All staff are required to follow these policies. It is mandatory that all project, shop, and office locations post this policy.

EPSP Specifics

<u>Waste:</u> All project, shop, and office locations find constructive and effective ways to reduce, reuse, and recycle waste products of all types. It is mandatory that project managers, coordinators, people responsible for purchasing products, and people utilizing such materials consider ways to use materials that already exist or avoid purchasing excessive amounts of materials as opposed to doing a thorough estimate of how much materials will be required.

It is the responsibility of the project leader to plan and implement containers, disposal sites, and haulers of waste, in bins, safe disposal containers, or recycling disposal sites.

It is the responsibility of the project leader and management to plan to avoid disposing soil, asphalt, concrete, or other building materials unnecessarily, in accordance with O.Reg 406/19.

Under no circumstances should materials be thrown away without the consent of the project leader or supervisor.

<u>Adjacent Environments</u>: Adjacent environments to our project (s) include water sources, water bodies or tributaries, drains and sewers, public or private properties, vegetation and wildlife habitat, and the atmosphere.

Protecting Adjacent Environments: It is mandatory that controls to protect adjacent environments be taken into consideration when planning and operating/constructing on a project. The project leader and management are responsible for the protection of all adjacent environments in accordance with the regulations. It is everyone's responsibility to ensure that these controls are maintained in orderly and operational fashion. It is mandatory that these controls are inspected and documented on an as needed basis (i.e. silt controls after a rainfall event).
